WHAT IS NEW

With program activity very limited due to safety restrictions by the Haitian government, the past few months have been full of projects which have continued to develop the campus, offer employment to local tradesmen and get more hands involved in the mission of PLH.

GATES

A local Camp Marie welder and his crew constructed two chain-link gates for the PLH property. These gates are a definite step up from the previous sheet metal and 2x4s.



JOB SKILLS TRAINING SCHOLARSHIPS

This year, two young men completed the Level 1 welding training at Extollo on scholarships from PLH. They look forward to learning from and working alongside the skilled welders who will come to erect the vocational center and multipurpose building.

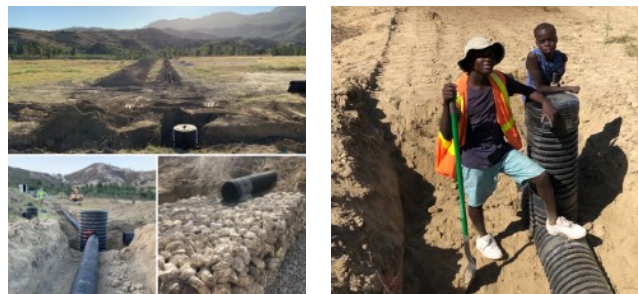
CISTERN

Three masons from Camp Marie and the surrounding area created a cistern which will allow for easy access to water for projects and future classes in the vocational center.



DRAINAGE PIPE

The Oregon construction team supervised the installation of drainage pipe on the two soccer fields. Last year, these fields would have standing water that would take a week of clear weather to dry. This year, these pipes effectively divert that water leaving the fields clear.



BUILDING PADS

A crew of over 30 men mixed and poured the concrete by hand to complete the two building pads for the vocational center and multipurpose building.

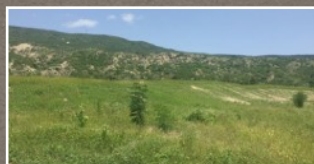
JOB SKILLS TRAINING SCHOLARSHIPS

Four men who completed Level 1 masonry training at Extollo in 2019 on scholarship from PLH were hired as concrete finishers for the building pads and were able to learn even more from the Oregon construction team.



EROSION CONTROL

If you remember the erosion the field edges suffered last year, you will be happy to hear that, with the assistance of straw erosion mats, vegetation is growing along the slopes stabilizing the dirt and making the campus greener every day.



SOCCER ACADEMY

After the first season of the youth soccer league last year, the PLH team developed an adjusted academy model which provides more discipleship opportunities, more focused attention and training and hand-selected coaches. This model will still allow for league play with teams from surrounding areas while better ministering to the youth in the immediate area. The academy was set to be launched in April; however, with Covid restrictions the launch had to be delayed. The academy is now set to launch in September!
